The Central Board of Secondary Education has introduced the scheme of Continuous and Comprehensive Evaluation for Grades 6 to 8 in its schools in a phased manner from the academic year 2011-2012.

The assessment will cover both scholastic and co-scholastic aspects and will be carried out in schools over the two terms, **Term 1 and Term 2** by means of formative and summative assessments using a variety of tests and assignments. For purpose of teaching and assessment, the syllabus for different subjects has been bifurcated for the two terms.

There will be four Formative Assessments each of with a weighting of 10% each. There are two Summative Assessments (SA1 and SA2) with a weighting of 30% each.

First Term: FA1 (10%) + FA2 (10%) + SA1 (30%) = 50%

Second Term: FA3 (10%) + FA4 (10%) + SA2 (30%) = 50%

Formative Assessment will be carried through using multiple modes of assessment such as assignments, quizzes, debates, Group discussions, Projects and only one **pen and paper test**.

The Summative Assessment is a written, end of the term examination which may consist of objective type, short answer and long answer questions. For making evaluation comprehensive, both scholastic and co-scholastic aspects will be given importance. Co-scholastic areas will consist of Life-Skills, Attitudes and Values, Co-scholastic Activities and Health and Physical Education.
