Dear Parents,

We at Jain Heritage School comprehend the angst and uncertainty experienced by each one of you after having heard about the inhumane act at an international school recently.

It has always been the primary concern of our school management to ensure safety of all students at our school.

- The security staff has been instructed to thoroughly check the visitors' entry to the school.
- All security, support staff, admin staff & teaching have been briefed to exercise vigilance at all time and report the presence of any unauthorized person to the concerned authority.
- CCTV cameras have been installed at all vantage points in the school premises.
- Movement of students is always supervised and security has been deployed at all strategic points to ensure safety of the students.
- No student can leave the school premises during school hours. In case of emergency, child is handed over to the parent after signing the gate pass which is counter signed by the concerned authority.
- Regular awareness programs (Good Touch, Bad touch) are conducted for students by our school counselors to identify uncomfortable situations and report to the nearest available trusted adult as early possible.
- Parent ID Cards will be issued to the students who are picked by parents.
- All the faculty members have been sensitized to maintain a respectable distance from students & have been asked to strictly adhere to "No Touch" policy with the students.
- Also concerns of any students against misbehavior by anyone will be dealt seriously.
- There is a lady support staff deployed in all wash rooms.
- The children are always accompanied by trained ayahs to the wash rooms.



- Students are being supervised by class teachers, subject teachers and sports coaches during breakfast, lunch, snacks & sports.
- During dispersal, the class teacher and in charge teachers hand over the children to the parents, guardians & bus coordinator.
- The sub staff & drivers are continuously sensitized through workshops at regular intervals by the school counselors.

We want to assure you and seek your support and faith at such a delicate time, to strengthen our resolve in keeping JHS 'a home away from home' for all our students & make our school secure & safe.
