Srijith scores 199 in Jain Heritage win

A brilliant century by KL Srijith helped Jain Heritage School beat Kendriya Vidyalaya

(RWF) by 149 wickets in the KSCA Cup for School tournament Division-II for under-16 boys. Srijith was however unlucky to have missed on a deserving double century by just one run. Batting first Srijith led from the front as he made 199 runs as Jain Heritage posted a mammoth 374 runs for the loss of five wickets. He was will supported by Abhijit Murugan, who scored a half century before getting out on 59. In reply Kendriya Vidyalaya were bowled out for 235 runs in the 40th over with Ankit Udupa and Likhith Bannur picking up four wickets each for the winners. Imran scored 97 runs for Kendriya Vidyalaya, but that wasn't enough to cause an upset.

In another match, Anirudha Ratti scored an unbeaten half century as Sri Vani Education Centre School got the better of St Claret High School by five wickets. Batting first Sujith Gowda and Dheeraj made 50 runs each as St Claret posted 234 runs for the loss of six wickets in the allotted 50 overs. In reply, Ratti remained not out on 74 as his team reached the target losing five wickets with 20 balls to spare. Adhitya Shekar (31) and Amshul (28) also made useful contribution for the winners.
