# UNSC

The Security Council approaches the unpleasant but agreeable truth and that colonialism has not disappeared. In fact, it has evolved into a geopolitical play of influence that manifests through economic pressure, sanctions, diplomatic leverage, and extraterritorial enforcement of laws. The actions of The United States of America towards the State of Venezuela serve as a pivotal case study in how influential states can shape the internal trajectory of weaker states without direct occupation.

The motive of the council is to propel the proxies to grapple with the paradox of interference fabricated as protecting diplomacy, human rights and regional stability, all while simultaneously enfeebling a state's political sovereignty and economic self sufficiency.

You'll have to expect to defend, even argue that external intervention prevents humanitarian collapse or conversely that it entrenches economic suffering and political instability. The debate challenges you to question where lawful influence ends and contemporary colonisation begins...an issue that continues to reshape global power dynamics.

You will interrogate whether divergent regulatory regimes risk creating competing monetary blocs, weakening capital controls, and destabilizing exchange systems. You will expect sharp debate over monetary sovereignty, technological dominance, data governance, and regulatory leverage. This committee challenges participants to determine whether financial architecture will remain globally integrated or splinter into competing digital ecosystems.

This agenda invites delegates to examine how education systems, family structures, mental health access, community resilience, and digital governance intersect with transnational organized crime. Participants will assess gaps in platform accountability, digital evidence sharing, financial tracking, narcotics interdiction, and youth diversion programs, recognizing the uneven enforcement capacity between states and the speed at which criminal networks adapt.

Delegates are challenged to design integrated prevention and enforcement strategies that protect young people without criminalizing vulnerability or undermining fundamental rights. This discussion will emphasize responsibility, innovation, and long-term resilience, shaping whether digital spaces evolve into pathways for opportunity or recruitment corridors for criminal exploitation.

With special emphasis on Bangladesh, you'll examine how political mobilization, institutional gaps, communal narratives, and weak accountability mechanisms allow religious oppression to persist despite formal democratic frameworks. These dynamics expose the tension between legal commitments and ground realities, where protection is uneven and trust in institutions remains fragile.

You will be forced to defend morally complex positions, balancing sovereignty against international responsibility, cultural sensitivity against universal rights, and political stability against accountability. You also must confront the gap between international norms and domestic enforcement capacity, where communities prioritize immediate safety and dignity over procedural assurances.

These debates mirror ongoing human rights challenges worldwide, making the committee's deliberations deeply relevant and consequential.

# FCTF



The Federal Criminal Task Force confronts an uncomfortable reality that power, when protected by wealth, political influence, and institutional inertia, can operate beyond the reach of justice. The Epstein network represents more than criminal misconduct. It exposes how prosecutorial discretion, regulatory failure, and elite protection can distort accountability within modern governance.

What began as isolated abuse evolved into a complex web of financiers, facilitators, legal mechanisms, and compromised oversight. In addition, non prosecution agreements, sealed settlements, and jurisdictional maneuvering challenge the credibility of the justice system and raise questions about equality before the law.

The committee compels delegates to confront the paradox of institutions claiming to uphold rule of law and human rights, while enabling prosecution and the silencing victims. You must defend, or contest, whether shielding influential actors preserves stability and institutional legitimacy, or whether it entrenches inequality, public distrust, and systemic abuse.

This crisis asks where lawful discretion ends and engineered protection begins, and whether transparency can survive in systems shaped by concentrated power. The outcomes will redefine not only this investigation, but the integrity of justice itself.
