Former Director General of Police, Karnataka State.

Shri **Shankar Mahadev Bidari**, a distinguished police officer, was born on **27th August 1954** in Galagali village, Bagalkot District, Karnataka. Son of Shri Mahadevappa Bidari, an agriculturist and cooperative leader, and Smt. Guravva, a homemaker, his upbringing was rooted in values of discipline, integrity, and service.

He completed his early education in **Banahatti** and went on to pursue higher studies at **G.I. Bagewadi College, Nipani**, later graduating with a **B.A. in Economics, Political Science, and History** from Karnataka University in 1975.

Shri Bidari professional journey led him into public service, where he joined the **Karnataka Administrative Service (KAS)** as an **Assistant Commissioner** in 1977. His quest for larger responsibilities drove him to the **Indian Police Service (Karnataka Cadre, RR 1978)**.

During his **34 years of service in the IPS**, Shri Bidari held several prestigious positions across Karnataka and earned a reputation for being a fearless, upright, and people-friendly officer. Known for his decisive action against organized crime, he was instrumental in strengthening law enforcement across the state.

His tenure saw him head various critical departments, culminating in his appointment as the **Director General of Police (DGP), Karnataka State**. He retired from service on **31st May 2012**, leaving behind a legacy of honesty, discipline, and commitment to public welfare.
